





### Critical Reflection Resources

#### See-Think-Wonder

(Harvard Project Zero, 2019)

- HPZ "Thinking Routines"
- An intentional methodology:
  - What do you see/hear?
  - What do you think about what you see/hear (assumptions, interpretations)?
  - What do you wonder?

## A Thinking Lens ® for Reflective Teaching (Curtis, 2017)

- 6 elements, each with reflective questions to consider. For example:
  - Knowing Yourself: How am I reacting to this situation and why? What in my background is influencing my responses and why?


## Collaborative Dialogue

"This process opens avenues for discussion not to find answers but to explore the different ways of thinking about pedagogy, and to invite reflection on assumptions, values, and unquestioned understandings." (p.50)



## Quick Summary, so far...

- Changes in society in Canada and beyond are re-shaping the way we think about children, their care, their learning, their education.
- Those changes (values, beliefs, knowledge, legislation, etc.) are requiring that Education systems <u>and</u> Educators respond with/in their practices. Not evolving doesn't serve anyone.
- The BC Early Learning Framework (2019) is intended as a resource to support Educators (and systems) in navigating these responses. The Pedagogy of Listening, Critical Reflection, Collaborative Dialogue, and Pedagogical Narration are ALL practices that respond to these changes AND are intended to support children in facing this new (and somewhat unknown) future.
