BC Early Learning Framework (2019) - VISION



"Children can experiment, investigate, and inquire in ways that are relevant and meaningful to them. They are provided with opportunities to enrich and deepen their relationships with place, land, and community. Within the contexts of their individual and cultural identities, children are listened to and valued for their ideas and knowledge" (p.12).

BC Early Learning Framework (2019) **PRINCIPLES**

The BC Early Learning Framework states "The First Peoples Principles of Learning and the Early Learning Framework Principles may be **considered in many different ways** and are intended to inspire pedagogies **for all children**, **families, and communities**, regardless of ethnicity, gender, sexuality, culture, language, abilities, or socio- economic status" (2019, p.14) First Peoples Principles of Learning (FNESC, 2008)

Pedagogies & Practices

"The Early Learning Framework does not prescribe specific 'how-tos' of practice or suggest a 'right way' to work with children and families. Rather, it is intended to inspire pedagogical approaches that are relevant and respectful of local communities and the people who live in those communities"

(Government of BC, 2019, p.6)
